Summary

Workshop aim to improve the attendance abilities in identifying and actively participate in managing postnatal depression. It includes view on perinatal mental health of the mother and use of Edinberg post-natal depression score to identify mot her with depression symptom. Workshop include view on WHO program (THINKING HEALTHY) that support mothers with postpartum depression. The workshop included interactive activities, discussions, and role-playing scenarios.

Background:

Postpartum depression (PPD) is a significant mental health condition that affects approximately 10-20% of women after childbirth. It can manifest within the first few weeks following delivery, though it may also arise up to a year postpartum.

Despite its prevalence, PPD is frequently underdiagnosed and undertreated due to the stigma surrounding mental health issues and a lack of awareness among caregivers and healthcare providers.

Research indicates that untreated PPD can lead to negative outcomes such as impaired mother-infant bonding, developmental delays in infants, and increased stress within family relationships.

This workshop aims to equip participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to identify signs of postpartum depression effectively, facilitate open discussions about maternal mental health, and help connect mothers with the appropriate resources.

- 3-To develop skills for initiating supportive conversations with new mothers, including how to approach sensitive topics related to mental health.


